ALL PERSONS MUST REPORT TO RECEPTION BEFORE ENTERING ANY OF THE WATER AREAS

General

- When bringing a guest to play sport please contact Reception on arrival so that the necessary **indemnities** can be signed
- **A Day visitors** fee will be applicable
- Children aged 17 and younger must always be under the direct supervision of an adult whilst on the property.
- **No alcoholic beverages to be brought onto the Club premises**
- With the risk of fires there are no braaiing facilities.
- **Smoking in** designated smoking area. The main building and veranda area are smoke free zones
- Please place all litter in bins
- Please do not chase any of the wildlife you find on the fields and around the club.
- **Only Members** are allowed to walk their dogs. **Dogs need to be leashed at all times**
- **We have a pet friendly seating area.** The buildings and veranda are a pet free zone

Parking

- Parking is allocated to the tarred area at the main club house.
- Should you need to drop something at the water's edge please notify the Reception before driving down to the water's edge.
- **Only drop and go will be allowed at the water's edge – NO PARKING.** All vehicles, trailers, bikes must be returned to the main parking area.
